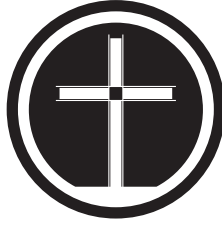

**Call to Confession**  
1 John 2:1-2

**Public Confession**
